



## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CLINICAL DATA FORM (PYCD)

### I. General Instructions

The PYP Clinical Data Form is completed during the interview portion of the participant's appointment. It is used to assess medical conditions and diseases.

Questions must be put to the participant exactly as they are printed. Small changes may make unexpectedly large differences in responses. Unequivocal answers must be recorded as such, whether they seem reasonable or not. Probing questions should rarely be needed. When they have to be asked, they should depart as little as possible from the wording of the initial question and must not suggest any particular answer to the respondent.

### II. Detailed Instructions for Each Item

- 0a. Enter the date the form is completed.
- 0b. Enter the staff code of the person who is completing the form.
- 1-4. Using the prompt indicated on the form, ask the participant whether they have ever been told by their doctor that they have each condition listed on the form. Record the participant's response to each question. If the participant does not answer, or responds that they do not know, indicate "No" as the participant's response.
- 5-14. Using the prompt indicated on the form, ask whether the participant has experienced any of the symptoms intermittently or continuously for more than 2 weeks during the past 6 months. Record the participant's response as "Yes" or "No". If the participant answers "Yes-intermittently", or "Yes-continuously", it is sufficient to indicate the participant's response simply as "Yes". If the participant does not answer, or responds that they do not know, indicate "No" as the participant's response.
- 15-16. Ask the questions as indicated by the prompt on the form. For each question, record the participant's response. If the participant does not answer, or responds that they do not know, indicate "No" as the participant's response.
