It is important that you do not move your feet until I say it is time. If you feel unsteady, you should take a step to the side. Let me demonstrate." Feet should be approximately shoulder width apart and facing the end of the mat with the cables. "Please notice how I am not moving my feet as I go from standing quietly to rocking. Do you have any questions?" "To begin, I will ask you to stand facing me and march in place a few times." "Now stop, stand quietly in place for 30 seconds. After 30 seconds, I will tell you which way to lean without moving your feet. I will let you know when you can move your feet."
